
NBA's 2000 Ford 'Handy Man Van' To Be Donated

Depending on the amount of inquiries received the van will either be donated on a first-come, first-served basis OR to the Church / Ministry that the Association determines to be in the greatest need.


Autopsy of a Deceased Church Deacon Retreat Opportunities
